

- 1.) **Bonnet Springs**, 386-362-1001, located at Peacock Springs State Park in Live Oak, Florida. This spring has a pool area that is 70 ft. wide & 7 ft. deep.
- 2.) **Branford Springs**, 386-362-1001, is located in Branford, Florida. This spring has a pool area that is 70 ft wide and 15 ft. deep.
- 3.) **Charles Springs**, 386-362-3004, located at 237th Dr. and 152nd St. in Live Oak, Florida. This is an 11 acre historic site on the Suwannee River. This spring has a paved boat ramp, picnicking, hiking, swimming and nature watching.

- 4.) **Falmouth Springs**, 386-362-1001, is located on 132 in Live Oak, Florida. This spring has swimming, picnicking, scuba diving, and nature watching.
- 5.) **Little River Springs**, 386-362-3004, located on County Road 242 in Branford, Florida. This spring has a cave system, swimming, diving, hiking, picnicking and nature watching.

- 6.) **Mattair Springs** is located on 75th Rd in Live Oak, Florida. This spring includes swimming and hiking.
- 7.) **Orange Grove Springs**, 386-362-1001, located at the Peacock Springs State Park in Live Oak, Florida. This spring includes cave diving and a pool area.
- 8.) **Peacock Springs**, 386-362-1001, located on SR 51 in Live Oak, Florida. This spring is the largest U.S. underground cave system. It includes: swimming, hiking, picnicking and a boat launch.
- 9.) **Royal Springs**, 386-362-3004, located at Suwannee Belle Estates 157th Lane in Live Oak, Florida. This spring includes boat ramp, picnicking, hiking, swimming, diving and nature watching. www.suwanneeparksandrecreation.org/Parks
- 10.) **Suwannee Springs**, 386-362-3071, located on 91st Dr. in Live Oak, Florida. This spring includes swimming, picnicking, sandy beach area and a pool area.
